FILEF invites you to its next information evening dedicated to advocacy for human rights. This month the theme is the rise of the far right and of new nationalisms in Europe, which is posing a serious threat to the social and civil rights gained after decades of political struggles. Xenophobia, homophobia and fear of diversity in general are spreading more and more among Europeans and are now a fully-fledged part of right-wing propaganda, aim of which is to scapegoat migrants, refugees and other minorities.



There will also be an update on a case of unfinished decolonization, in Western Sahara, where a struggle for independence has continued since Morocco's invasion of Western Sahara in 1975.
